ICH WEISS WAS DU NICHT SIEHST / I KNOW WHAT YOU DON'T SEE

Any artistic statement is both a proposition and a refusal: something is offered, and a lot remains concealed. Incomprehension is customary in the reception of an artwork, and maybe this is just as welcome as a viewer's recognition and understanding. Similarly, an artist conceives her/his work and its situatedness in an act of identification that inevitably includes failures, contradictions and misinterpretations.

The exhibition's title refers to the dialogic nature of any process of identifying, and it especially points to the absurd features inherent. ICH WEISS WAS DU NICHT SIEHST / I KNOW WHAT YOU DON'T SEE presents artists who aim to question conventional vantage points, and accordingly, the exhibition comprises multifaceted works in terms of form and content. To name but a few examples: there are the photographic series of Rabea Eipperle whose portraits taken in domestic settings reveal that individuality is a rather relative concept, and that staging and documenting may turn out to be the same. Then there are painters like Nikolaus List who engage in a perceptive dispute of pictorial traditions, playing the otherness of this time-honoured medium to its full potential. Iris Kettner's sculptures, in turn, at first sight resemble simple life-size depictions of city dwellers. Their hyperrealism soon gives way, however, to a complex set of allusions, ranging from voodoo dolls to fairy tales of supernatural forces empowering the humble.

21 artists have been invited to participate. Many of them cooperated with CAPRI Berlin in previous projects and some will present works especially devised for this project. During the exhibition, Kunstraum Kreuzberg will host a couple of special events organised by CAPRI Berlin and Thore Krietemeyer.
